Open call to join the WSA Safeguarding Advisers team

On September 16, the WSA Safeguarding working group met to resume initial discussions on the topic that took place during the World Council in Fatima last July.

The group, which consists of zone representatives, youth representatives, ISC members, and international helpers, explored the steps to be taken in this first stage toward establishing procedures to ensure the well-being and safety of Subud members, with the aim of establishing safeguard procedures for WSA.

It is hoped that the WSA will serve as a model for subud affiliates and the member countries, enabling them to implement their own procedures at the local, regional, and national levels in accordance with the legal regulations in each country.

To begin implementation as soon as possible, we are launching a call for skilled facilitators to join a team of safeguarding advisers. These contact persons should be from all age groups, both genders, and be language diverse. If you are interested in joining this team, please contact us at: safeguarding@subud.org

This group of contact should also be available to advise helpers in providing members with the best possible support.

As a first step, the WSA Safeguarding Working Group will design a poster that can be displayed at events, conferences, and group rooms. This is about making sure our Association is run in a way that actively deals with abuse, harassment, bullying,




How to plan a budget for the WSA

We need to do this to plan for next year. Last year as we just had been appointed a lot of it was new to us so we would like to share with you what it is all about.

The first two aims of the WSA are about facilitating the worship of Almighty God and preserving the Latihan kejiwaan in its original form so Helper Travel is a core activity that WSA supports. Wherever the International Helpers go there is an impact.

The preservation of the Talks of Bapak and Ibu Rahayu and how Subud evolved and grew that is the work of the Archives. They are the connection from the past to the presence of Subud. They make sure that we don't forget and that the Advice and Guidance of Bapak can always be traced back to the source. There are important projects going on from Digital Preservation to Archive Facilities.

Subud in the World is the umbrella for activities like SESI, SIHA, SYAI, ICT, Translation, SPI and Caresupport.

These are services that enable and encourage Subud members to take their Latihan into the world.

Of course, all this requires management, representation and interaction. That is what the WSA/ISC team does. The biggest factor there is the annual World Subud Council Meeting where all the decisions in between World Congresses are made. Maybe you notice some prominent omissions here. SDIA and SICA are affiliates that have their own budget. MSF is the World Subud Association's Foundation and has its own budget too.

Where does the money come from?



When the pledges and projected expenses of all the WSA/ISC entities are in, Marzuki puts it all together and we start the discussion within ISC. Very quickly you can see if requests are not in balance with the projected income. Then we will talk to the person that made the request. A draft budget goes to the wider WSA/ISC team, goes through changes and edits and is finally presented to the Board of Directors (Zone Representatives) for approval.


Every few months Elwyn, our accountant, gives us the actuals vs budget. That is a table that shows how do we perform in relation to the budget plan. There are always unexpected incomes or expenses and sometimes the budget needs revision. Then the changes needed are presented to the Board for approval.

There was a space for latihan available to us the whole time and big enough.



The blue Mediterranean sea was welcoming, with an especial welcome from the little biters, the small (thankfully) fish who wanted breakfast when we went for an early morning swim...not enough to deter us. It was just a few meters over the road, with canopies from the hotel and beach service if needed.



**Designing Change: Etienne Zambrano

As the Human Force prepares to send a team to Amanecer in January 2026, we spoke with architect and previous program participant Etienne Zambrano about his work bringing sustainable community spaces to life, and what volunteers can expect to experience firsthand!

At just 26, Colombian architect Etienne Zambrano is transforming learning



“For me, community projects are essential for cultural flourishing. Spaces only gain meaning when they’re filled with life — interactions between humans, and with the surrounding natural environment,” Etienne reflects: “Integrating these elements respectfully — culturally, socially, and historically — is what gives a project its true value and sustainability.”

With professional skills in low-impact, ecosystem-focused design, Etienne is now leading the reconstruction of Amanecer’s community Kiosko.

Etienne first joined Human Force in 2022, describing the experience as a “conscious engagement with the environment, surroundings, and human relationships.” That time inspired him to see the potential of design not just as structures, but as living spaces that nurture communities and connect people with nature.

A Lifetime of Subud Service

Lucian has dedicated over 55 years to Subud, serving in a wide range of roles across all levels of the organization. He began in 1970 as Membership Coordinator for Subud Detroit—just weeks after being opened—and later became local Chair and Helper. He went on to serve eight years as Midwest Regional Helper, followed by nine years as a SUSA National Helper, Vice-Chair, and Committee Councilor.

After a personal loss, Lucian continued his role from home, managing the SUSA Newsletter, website, and policy manual. Internationally, while testing at the Puebla World Congress didn't lead to immediate roles, he was soon appointed Executive Director of the Muhammad Subuh Foundation, a position he held for four years.

Most recently, Lucian completed a term as MSF Trustee and now serves as Corporate Secretary of the World Subud Association.
